

For 47 years, the Florida RV Trade Association (FRVTA) has been promoting and protecting the general welfare of the recreation vehicle and camping industries.

The Association was established in 1979 and has undergone many changes, and today stands as one of the largest and most successful state RV associations in the country.

The FRVTA is a non-profit (501-c-6) organization made up of campgrounds and resorts, RV dealers, finance and insurance company firms, RV manufacturers, and service and supplier companies representing thousands of employees. All of these companies work together to ensure that customers receive the finest RV products, services, supplies, and accommodations available. All FRVTA activities are coordinated through the state office located in Tampa, FL. The staff includes an Executive Director, Marketing Director, Show Director, and support staff.

The FRVTA has divided the state into seven regions, allowing members to participate in local legislative matters and RV shows. This also allows them to meet on a regular basis. Legislative matters are overseen by a full-time legal counsel located in the state capital of Tallahassee. This ensures that the voice of the RV industry is heard. FRVTA also supports candidates through the FRVPC Political Action Committee Fund.

The FRVTA sponsors a number of regional RV shows and the annual Florida RV SuperShow in Tampa (see page 4). These shows not only allow the public to view a number of various types and sizes of RVs, but they are also forums for educational seminars and camping clubs. They also provide an introduction to the wonderful world of RV travel. Through these shows and other activities, the FRVTA works closely with the state and tourism organizations to promote RVing and camping in Florida.





1. The southernmost part of the region offers a truly unique experience: a tour of the richly diverse wilderness swamp that is the Big Cypress National Preserve. The Big Cypress swamp's freshwater is essential to the health of the neighboring Everglades and the rich estuaries along Florida's southwest coast. The swamp can easily be experienced by the casual visitor via a boardwalk that winds through the ancient trees. Look for rare ferns, orchids, threatened bromeliads, native birds, and swamp creatures. 

3. Everglades City, Marco Island's mainland neighbor, is the Gulf Coast entrance to the mysterious and captivating Everglades National Park, and where you will find the Gulf Coast Visitor Center. The park's 1.5 million acres protect the southern 20 percent of the original Everglades, the largest remaining subtropical wilderness in the United States. The park, accessible here for tours, provides important habitat for numerous rare and endangered species like the manatee, American crocodile, and the elusive Florida panther. Everglades wildlife is suffering from the destructive force of an overpopulation of non-native Burmese pythons with voracious appetites.

5. In northern Collier County, about 30 minutes east of Naples, is a prime destination for birdwatchers and naturalists: Audubon's Corkscrew Swamp Sanctuary, near Immokalee. Corkscrew is an 11,000-acre wilderness that includes a 2.5-mile boardwalk through pine flatwoods, wet prairie, around a marsh, and into the largest old-growth bald cypress forest in North America, offering unique wildlife viewing and nature photography opportunities.

6. Don't overlook one of the state's most fascinating historical sites, the winter homes of Thomas Edison and Henry Ford, two famous friends who spent years as neighbors on the Caloosahatchee River in Fort Myers. Edison bought his property in 1906, and Ford bought the house next door in 1916. Only a fence – called the "Friendship Gate" by both families – separated the two estates. Visitors to the Edison and Ford Winter Estates can explore the homes, pool, gardens, museum, and Edison Botanical Laboratory, where the two famous inventors worked with Harvey Firestone to discover a local source of rubber that could be grown in the United States.

7.

The Fort Myers living history lesson includes the charming Murphy-Burroughs House, also known as the Burroughs Home and Gardens, where tour guides in 1920s-era costumes explain historical artifacts and share insight about Fort Myers' elite. Walk among live oaks and lush gardens, and watch the river roll by from a rocking chair on the veranda of this Georgian Revival mansion built in 1901, considered to be Fort Myers' first luxury residence. It was added to the National Historic Register in 1984.

8.

Visitors will find picturesque paths and historical gems tucked along Sanibel's main thoroughfare, Periwinkle Way, with shops, galleries, and restaurants framed by tall palms. Visit the Sanibel Historical Museum and Village, which accounts for the island's history, from the Calusa and Spanish eras to the early pioneer families who settled in the 1800s. On the east end of Periwinkle Way is one of the region's most photographed landmarks, the Sanibel Island Light, also known as Point Ybel Light, which was first illuminated in 1884 when the entire island was a wildlife refuge. It was the first lighthouse on Florida's Gulf coast north of Key West and the Dry Tortugas. Although the lighthouse itself is not open to the public, the grounds surrounding it are, and there is a scenic little beach and pier nearby for pictures.

The Circus Museum in Sarasota

9. Sarasota has long been known for its world-class cultural offerings. It's here that American circus owner John Ringling built Ca' d'Zan, modeled after the magnificent palazzos of Venice, as a love letter to his wife, Mable. This 36,000-square-foot Venetian Gothic villa served as their winter home and housed their priceless Baroque, Italian, and Flemish Renaissance art collection and exquisite 17th-century tapestries. Every piece in the collection at the John and Mable Ringling Museum of Art, established in 1927, is now owned by the state.

10. The Circus Museum in Sarasota, a collection of original circus art and artifacts, is located on the same grounds as the art museum, along with the historic Asolo Repertory Theatre, created in Asolo, Italy, in 1798, then relocated and installed on the Ringling property in 1957. A full restoration of the elaborate gilding and technology upgrades resulted in a grand reopening in 2006. The theatre offers a regular selection of productions throughout the year.



Top 10 *Nature, Arts & Culture* Places to Visit in Southeast Florida



1. A must stop for a Florida Keys vacation is Key West, the eclectic end of the continent, and just a 90-mile swim from Cuba. This southernmost point of the United States is home to a fascinating mix of history, eccentricity, and island charm. Civil War-era forts, famous writers' homes, sidewalk cafes, and unusual residents add to the unique atmosphere – and watching the sun set at the docks of Mallory Square is an experience not to be missed.

2. The Miami-Dade Zoological Park and Gardens, in western Miami-Dade County, is the largest and oldest zoological garden in Florida and the only subtropical zoo in the continental United States. Established in 1948, the 750-acre, state-of-the-art Zoo Miami is home to more than 500 animal species and more than 1,000 plant species. The zoo is proud to be an active leader in many global wildlife and environmental conservation initiatives. It is the fifth largest in the United States, and the unique climate in South Florida allows it to care for a wide variety of animals from Asia, Australia, Africa, and the Americas, representing a broad mix of species that is unlike any other zoo in the country.

Fairchild Tropical Botanic Garden

3. Coral Gables, home to the University of Miami, provides a wealth of dining, relaxation, and entertainment opportunities. The 83-acre Fairchild Tropical Botanic Garden, considered one of the best botanic gardens in the world, offers tram and walking tours through extensive collections of rare tropical plants, including palms, cycads, flowering trees, and vines. The site includes a museum, laboratory, learning center, and conservation research facility, and features exhibits, a rare-plant house, rainforest, and sunken gardens.

4. Broward County offers a variety of interests. The town of Lauderdale-by-the-Sea's living coral reef just 100 yards offshore is accessible to snorkelers and divers. Visitors may tour the 1907 Hillsboro Inlet Lighthouse in Hillsboro Beach, marking the northern limit of the Florida Reef. The historical landmark Hollywood Beach Boardwalk is popular for dawn-to-dark walking, cycling, and skating. Visit the Historic Stranahan House Museum, built in 1901 as a home for pioneers Frank and Ivy Stranahan and the oldest surviving structure in Broward County, located on the New River site where Fort Lauderdale began as a trading post in 1893. The Dr. Von D. Mizell-Eula Johnson State Park, a beachside park just south of Port Everglades and the last example of an undeveloped coastal ecosystem in Broward County, is popular for boating, swimming, fishing, hiking, bicycling, and picnicking.

5. At Big Cypress Seminole Indian Reservation off Alligator Alley, the Ah-Tah-Thi-Ki Museum, home to more than 200,000 unique artifacts, includes a mile-long boardwalk through a 60-acre cypress dome, offering opportunities to learn about Seminole culture and wildlife. The Big Cypress RV Resort features cabins, tent sites, and full hook-ups. It's owned and operated by the Seminole Tribe of Florida.

6. Visitors who seek a more urban safari instead may look no further than the Palm Beach boutiques and galleries of Worth Avenue, an upscale shopping and dining district. The Palm Beaches are known as the Gold Coast, a name reflecting the region's 47 miles of golden sand as well as its incredible wealth. Ever since railroad mogul Henry Flagler brought his railroad to town and erected fabulous hotels for his passengers, Palm Beach has been synonymous with luxury.

7. For a wild time on the western edge of West Palm Beach, visit Florida's only drive-through safari adventure and walk-through amusement park. Lion Country Safari's 600-acre wildlife preserve protects more than 900 animals, from giraffes and bison to elephants and lions, and includes animal feeding experiences, six rides, a water spray ground, food, shopping, and more. The 4-mile drive through the safari preserve is divided into seven main habitats.

Located at 284 Margaret St. on the side of the Cuban Coffee Queen stand, this postcard-style mural proudly celebrates Key West's status as the southernmost city in the continental U.S. With vivid colors and iconic imagery — from conch shells to classic architecture — it's a favorite photo spot for visitors exploring the island's artistic soul. Just steps from Bahama Village and the Historic Seaport, the mural is part of a larger tapestry of public art that reflects the island's vibrant culture and laid-back vibe.

8. Fishing enthusiasts will want to try the waters off Stuart, known as the "Sailfish Capital of the World." Convenient and intriguing alternatives to the beach include Florida Oceanographic Coastal Center, a 57-acre marine life nature center, an educational and research site with a network of nature trails, a lagoon, and saltwater tanks. The Hutchinson Island center, managed by the Florida Oceanographic Society, offers educational programs for all ages and conducts research and restoration programs that lead to healthy coastal ecosystems.
9. Off the Fort Pierce coast, recreational divers can explore Urca de Lima, a 1715 Spanish shipwreck opened to the public in the 1980s as the state's first Underwater Archaeological Preserve. It was part of the 1715 Treasure Fleet, one of the numerous Spanish treasure fleets that sailed between Spain and her colonies in the Americas, and sank during a hurricane. The shipwreck is part of the U.S. National Park Service.

10. Vero Beach hosts McKee Botanical Garden, listed on the National Register of Historic Places and known for its subtropical jungle hammock. It was founded in 1929 when Waldo Sexton and Arthur G. McKee purchased an 80-acre tropical hammock along the Indian River. For visitors to Vero Beach and the surrounding areas, it is a popular surfing, scuba diving, paddling, and saltwater fishing haven. Sebastian Inlet State Park is also home to many types of shorebirds and migratory species, making it a stop on the Great Florida Birding and Wildlife Trail. The park hosts two museums: the McLarty Treasure Museum, a national historical landmark situated on a campsite for survivors of a 1715 Spanish fleet, and the Sebastian Fishing Museum, commemorating early fishing families.







1. Winter Haven, first homesteaded in the 1860s, is where a young George Jenkins opened the first Publix Food Store in 1930. However, it was Cypress Gardens in 1936 that opened the eyes of the world to the beauty of Florida. Its water ski shows, gardens, and Southern traditions were once one of the biggest attractions in Florida. Today, the site is LEGOLAND Florida Resort, which includes a theme park, water park, and aquarium. Opened in 2011, LEGOLAND preserved the beautiful gardens in its 145-acre layout and offers more than 50 attractions over 14 themed lands, including multiple roller coasters and a water slide to fit its amazing collection of giant Lego figures. Lego Movie World is based on the company's movie franchises and offers three themed rides, character meet-and-greets, and a giant playground for kids.

2. Ybor City, where Tampa's historic Latin Quarter is rich in Spanish, Italian, Greek, and Cuban traditions, is a popular destination. Founded as a cigar-manufacturing center, Ybor City is one of only two National Historic Landmark Districts in Florida.

History buffs can visit the Ybor City Museum State Park inside the former Ferlita Bakery building, where a cigar industry walking tour also begins. The area offers lively nightlife, hand-rolled cigars, and some of the best food around, including the historic Columbia Restaurant, the oldest restaurant in Florida, owned by the same family since 1905. Enjoy a Cuban sandwich at Barrio Tacos or Carmine's Restaurant & Bar, or dine on home-style Northern Italian cuisine at La Terrazza (limited hours).

3. Riverwalk is a wonderful way to experience the downtown Tampa waterfront. A continuous pedestrian walkway from the Channelside district to Tampa Heights along the east side of the Hillsborough River, Riverwalk connects Tampa's dynamic cultural venues and incorporates interpretive elements, parks, retail, and restaurants. Busts of prominent Tampa citizens continue to be added along the route of this phased project. Armature Works, a fully restored mixed-use building on the curve of the river, provides a variety of food and drink offerings, event spaces, and co-working spaces located amongst open seating and a wide patio.

4. The Florida Aquarium, located in the Channelside district, is a large-scale aquarium that allows visitors to get up close to many of Florida's aquatic and terrestrial animals and ecosystems, as well as other animals from around the world. Its conservation mission includes efforts to save the imperiled Florida Reef Tract and involves customized laboratories and innovative research.




Florida WINERIES

The rich abundance of fruits and flowers that earned Florida its name centuries ago from Spanish explorers included native grapevines on Florida's east coast. It wasn't long before Spanish settlers applied their winemaking skills to Florida's wild muscadine grapes to create the first American wine.

Florida's subtropical climate, rich soils, and hilly terrain provide just the right combination for muscadine grapes to thrive. Today's avid vintners harvest a variety of fruits that contribute to the wine being made at 40 wineries scattered across the state. The Florida wine industry generated \$20.09 billion in total economic activity in 2025, according to WineAmerica. The industry supports 126,662 jobs, including direct employment and roles in farming, transportation, packaging, and more.

Florida's vineyards, wineries, and flavorful wines are interesting parts of Florida history that few people know about, but more and more families are discovering them as they look beyond the beaches and amusement parks. Florida's wine regions in 2025 attracted more than 450,000 tourists and accounted for \$86 million in tourism spending. Visitors can stroll through a vineyard, view a harvest, watch the winemaking, corking, bottling, and labeling processes, and sample the wonderful and distinctive varieties of delicious Florida wines.

5. Award-winning ZooTampa at Lowry Park is a nonprofit dedicated to rescuing, rehabilitating, and caring for animals while connecting people to wildlife in fun and immersive ways. Visitors can take a guided tour through an African habitat, see a critical care manatee center, or pet and feed stingrays in Stingray Shores, a 30,000-gallon tank. After discovering the zoo, discover the thrills of Roaring Springs, where families board a boat

and gently drift along a crystal-clear spring surrounded by native landscape and endangered Florida wildlife, before a sudden turn drops guests three stories to splash down. The less adventurous can experience the splash on the Canopy Walk, overlooking the attraction.

6. In Clearwater, at the Clearwater Marine Aquarium, the nonprofit whose mission is to Rescue, Rehab, and Release, visitors get a fish-eye view of mangroves and seagrass, critical nursery habitats for juvenile fish, and watch live web cams. Staff provide effective care to sick or injured animals with the goal of returning them to their homes. Overlooking the Gulf of Mexico, Pier 60 in Clearwater Beach features a 1,080-foot fishing pier and recreational park, with a bait house, telescopes, and six covered pavilions. It offers a sunset celebration modeled after Key West's popular Mallory Square festival, nightly from 6-9 p.m. Craftsmen, artists, and entertainers perform two hours before and after sunset.

7. The city of St. Petersburg is home to art galleries, antique shops, museums, and the signature iconic St. Pete Pier. The Pier features various levels with observation platforms, shops, restaurants, and balconies offering great views of Tampa Bay. The Pier also includes event space, a beach area, a fishing deck, and an interactive water feature. Downtown museums include the Museum of Fine Arts, opened in 1965 and home to exhibits spanning 4,000 years, including African art, European paintings, American photography, a Steuben glass gallery, and a sculpture garden. The Dali Museum holds an unparalleled collection of the famed surrealist's paintings, the largest outside of Europe, with more than 2,000 works of art. The James Museum of Western and Wildlife Art, opened in 2018, is home to the vast personal collection of co-founders Tom and Mary James, including collected works in oil, ink, and stone that evoke the spirit and beauty of a wide-open frontier.

8. Sunken Gardens is a botanical paradise in the midst of bustling St. Petersburg that includes an interactive children's museum. As St. Petersburg's oldest living museum, the more than 100-year-old Sunken Gardens is home to some of the oldest tropical plants in the region. Visitors stroll along meandering paths, lush with exotic plants from around the world, through cascading waterfalls, beautiful demonstration gardens, and more than 50,000 tropical plants and flowers. Great Explorations Children's Museum, located next door to Sunken Gardens, is a separate nonprofit hands-on museum designed for children under 10, featuring various interactive exhibits and programs.

9. The 1,136-acre Fort DeSoto Park, the largest in Pinellas County, is made up of five interconnected islands and is home to more than 330 species of birds documented over the last 60 years, making it one of the most popular birding destinations in the United States. It rates among the top 10 U.S. beaches and offers visitors a peaceful refuge. More than a beautiful beach and a great place to camp, it includes a historic fort and museum. Another spectacular spot is Egmont Key, an island that lies southwest of Fort DeSoto in the mouth of Tampa Bay, accessible only by boat. A ferry departs for Egmont Key State Park from Fort DeSoto's bay pier. Primarily a wildlife refuge, this island is also a place to collect shells along secluded, pristine beaches.

10. On the Gulf coast is Tarpon Springs, a seaside village settled by Greek sponge divers at the turn of the century, where visitors will enjoy delicious Greek pastries and shoppers will find treasures in markets with a Mediterranean flair. At the Tarpon Springs Heritage Museum, you can learn about the history of Tarpon Springs and the sponge industry. Nicholas Toth handcrafted sponge diving helmets, a craft he learned from his grandfather, Anthony Lerios. Lerios came to the area in 1913 and was renowned for his helmets that helped fuel the sponge industry. Toth carries on the tradition in a small shop nearby, investing 350 hours to make one iconic helmet.

Murals in Region 3: The West

Central Florida Region, which stretches through the Tampa, St. Petersburg, Clearwater area to Lakeland and Winter Haven, and north to Brooksville, is already an artsy region enhanced by numerous murals.

In St. Petersburg, the whimsical “Phoebe & Friends” mural by Bunnie Reiss brings a burst of magic to the city’s dynamic art scene. Installed in 2023 at MTBH Studios on Central Avenue, this mural was part of the SHINE Mural Festival, a celebrated event that has transformed St. Pete into a global mural destination. Inspired by flamingos — both the sculpture at Tampa International Airport and real ones that moved in after Hurricane Idalia — the mural features Reiss’s signature folk-art style, blending bright colors, playful patterns, and mystical creatures.

Bunnie Reiss, a California-based artist with Eastern European roots, is known for turning everyday spaces into enchanted realms. Her work in St. Pete adds to the city’s reputation as a canvas for creativity and community spirit. Whether you’re an art lover or a curious traveler, “Phoebe & Friends” offers a joyful, photo-worthy experience that captures the heart of St. Pete’s artistic vibe.

In Downtown Tampa, the iconic Tampa Postcard mural is more than a photo op — it’s a vibrant tribute to the city’s rich heritage and evolving identity. Originally commissioned in 2003 and repainted in 2012, the mural by Carl Cowden III helped spark Tampa’s public art renaissance. Each letter in the word “TAMPA” is filled with imagery that captures the city’s spirit: the Gasparilla pirate ship, the University of Tampa’s minarets, historic streetcars, and children fishing along the Hillsborough River. Cowden blended his background in sign painting with Art Nouveau influences to create a piece that’s both nostalgic and visually striking.

Located at the intersection of Florida Avenue and Royal Street, the mural welcomes visitors with a colorful reminder of Tampa’s charm and diversity. Whether you’re exploring downtown or attending a nearby event, this mural offers the perfect backdrop for a memorable visit—and a deeper appreciation of the city’s story.

In the heart of Brooksville, the Bear Mural stands as a stunning tribute to the state’s wild heritage and a gateway to the Florida Wildlife Corridor, a statewide network of nearly 18 million acres of connected land and water supporting wildlife and people. Painted by award-winning artist Justin Alsedek on the walls of City Hall, this is the largest mural in Brooksville’s history and a centerpiece of a statewide initiative to raise awareness about Florida’s protection corridor project. The mural features native wildlife — including the Florida Brown Bear and the endangered Brooksville Bellflower — set against a backdrop of the region’s lush landscapes.

Brooksville’s location is a vital link between the Green Swamp and the Chassahowitzka National Wildlife Refuge, making it a hotspot for biodiversity and outdoor recreation. Visitors can hike, kayak, explore nearby trails, then admire the mural that captures the essence of Florida’s natural beauty. It’s not just art — it’s a call to protect the wild spaces that make Florida extraordinary.





Top 10 Nature, Arts & Culture Places to Visit in East Central Florida

1. In Kissimmee, Gatorland, a favorite “real Florida” attraction for decades, offers a variety of guest adventures, including the Gator Night Shine tour, Croc Rock, Stompin’ Gator Off-Road Adventure, and Trainer for a Day. The Screamin’ Gator Zipline sends visitors flying over 1,200 feet from towers standing seven stories high, and the Gator Gauntlet Zipline takes visitors over the Alligator Breeding Marsh.


2. Orlando’s main attractions, which draw visitors from around the world, include the renowned theme parks offered by Disney, Universal, and SeaWorld. SeaWorld Adventure Park is a wonderful place to be entertained while learning more about whales, dolphins, sea lions, and other marine creatures. Murals in Region 4: Sprawling ranches can still be found inland in East Central Florida, lending credence to the historical stories of land grants, citrus cultivation, and battles between natives and settlers. The mural project was the brainchild of local business owner Kristin Koldenhoven, who envisioned the alley as a way to bring foot traffic and community pride to the area. Today, families, teens, and even pets pose for photos in front of the colorful artwork, making it a joyful stop for locals and visitors alike. Surrounded by shops and cafés, the mural alley offers a perfect blend of art, charm, and small-town hospitality.

In Melbourne's Eau Gallie Arts District, the "Wave" mural at the Eau Gallie Library is a striking mosaic that blends art, education, and community spirit. fun rides, interactive experiences, character meets, and a daily parade. A Dolphin Nursery underwater viewing window lets visitors see dolphin calves jump and play with their moms. SeaWorld's Aquatica water park includes KareKare Curl, a curve-shaped wave attraction for two passengers that delivers a high-adrenaline, weightless adventure. The park also includes Discovery Cove by SeaWorld. Discovery Cove is a reservations-only tropical park where guests can swim and interact with dolphins, tropical fish, sharks, and stingrays.

3. Orlando's Walt Disney World includes four theme parks, two water parks, and an entertainment complex, Disney Springs, with shopping and dining. Magic Kingdom, Epcot, Hollywood Studios, and Disney's Animal Kingdom provide visitors with numerous exciting rides, including Mickey & Minnie's Runaway Railway, the Twilight Zone Tower of Terror, the Indiana Jones Epic Stunt Spectacular, Pandora - The World of Avatar, Expedition Everest - Legend of the Forbidden Mountain, and Tiana's Bayou Adventure, to name a few.

4. Orlando's Universal Orlando Resort complex includes four theme parks - Universal Studios Florida, Universal Islands of Adventure, Universal's Volcano Bay, and Universal Epic Universe, which opened in 2025 and features five themed worlds: Celestial Park, The Wizarding World of Harry Potter - Ministry of Magic, SUPER NINTENDO WORLD, How to Train Your Dragon Isle of Berk, and Dark Universe. Universal offers 11 resort hotels plus CityWalk, a 30-acre shopping, dining, and entertainment area that includes the world's largest Hard Rock Cafe. The theme parks combine technology with some of the world's most beloved characters, drawing visitors from around the globe.

5. Just a bit north of Orlando, in Seminole County, the Wekiva River flows through the shade of a semi-tropical forest. Wekiwa Springs State Park, located at the headwaters of the river, provides for horseback riding, fishing, bird watching, and nature hiking on 13 miles of trails. A canoe trip is the best way to experience the river, and several canoe outfitters operate nearby.

6. East of the Orlando region is Florida's Space Coast, including Cocoa Beach, Cape Canaveral, Melbourne/Palm Bay, and Titusville, which allows visitors a chance to spend sunny days on the beach, learn about space exploration at the Kennedy Space Center, and commune with nature at Canaveral National Seashore and the 140,000-acre Merritt Island National Wildlife Refuge. The refuge, an overlay of the space center, was established in 1963 as a buffer zone for rocket launches. The coastal site is a major wintering area for migratory birds located on the Atlantic Flyway, a key corridor for migration, and currently protects 15 federally listed species. At Kennedy Space Center, visitors can hear veteran NASA pilots tell their stories at the Astronaut Encounter Theater or view the history of space travel through exhibits and actual rockets.

7. The Daytona Beach area also offers historical sites with surprising twists. At Dunlawton Sugar Mill Gardens in Port Orange, visitors can explore extensive botanical gardens surrounding the ruins of an 1832 plantation sugar mill. The original Dunlawton plantation's history began before Florida became a state in 1845. Visit the Museum of Arts and Sciences in Daytona Beach for a unique combination of art, science, and history. Large permanent collections include African, American, Chinese, Cuban, Floridian, and Decorative Arts. The digital state-of-the-art Lowell and Nancy Lohman Family Planetarium, along with Expedition Dinosaur, newly opened in fall 2025, allows visitors to explore and learn.

8. The coast in Ormond Beach, in Volusia County at the region's northern tip, was once the playground for America's early millionaires, including oil magnate John D. Rockefeller. The city played host in 1903 to Florida's first auto races on its smooth, hard-packed beaches, earning it the title "Birthplace of Speed." Today, in addition to the Birthplace of Speed Park, Ormond Beach offers quiet beachside vacations and tours of The Casements, Rockefeller's mansion and former winter home, and the current Ormond Beach cultural center and park. The 30-plus miles of natural scenery along the Ormond Scenic Loop & Trail, called "The Loop" by locals, draws motorcyclists from around the world.

9. Visitors to the northern part of the region will find the small town of DeLand interesting, once named the best downtown in the nation in America's Main Street competition. Stetson University, Florida's oldest college, is located there. DeLand's commitment to community and the city's successful efforts to revitalize the once-struggling downtown area set it apart. Visitors can stroll along a charming row of quaint shops, boutiques, and cafes, while three state parks and a national wildlife refuge offer nature encounters.

10. Nearby Blue Spring State Park in Orange City is a favorite place to see manatees in the winter and swim in cool, clear water in the summer. The park stays open late mid-March to mid-April for visitors to experience "Firefly Nights," when thousands of fireflies light up the woods.






Tallahassee Historic Capitol

1. Tallahassee, Florida's capital, is geographically closer to Atlanta than Miami. It exudes the charm of a small Southern city with its oak-canopied roads, colorful azaleas, and rolling hills. Visiting RVers will enjoy touring the state seat of government, including the Old Capitol, restored to its 1902 American Renaissance splendor with red candy-striped awnings and a stained-glass dome. Behind the historic Capitol is the New Capitol, complete with a 22nd-floor observation deck offering a 360-degree view of the area, including, on a clear day, shimmering blue water to the south. Near the Capitol is the campus of Florida State University.

2. Just to the southwest of the city, a 52-acre natural habitat is the home of red wolves, Florida panthers, and river otters at the Tallahassee Museum. This privately funded, nonprofit museum, for over 60 years, has combined a natural habitat zoo, nature trails, natural gardens, rare historic buildings, and educational programs to become one of the most unique museums in the South.



3. The Edward Ball Wakulla Springs State Park, a 6,000-acre wildlife sanctuary located south of Tallahassee, offers hiking, biking, or a river boat tour along the Wakulla River and one of the world's deepest and largest freshwater springs. Step back to slower times with a stay at The Lodge at Wakulla Springs, an elegant hotel surrounded by pristine forest built in 1937 and listed along with the park on the National Register of Historic Places.
4. The Cape St. George Lighthouse originally stood for 153 years on St. George Island before falling in 2005. It was rebuilt using as much of the original brick and other materials as possible, 72-feet high, in a new location in 2008. A museum and keeper's house on site are open for seasonal tours. This beautiful barrier island includes St. George Island State Park and miles of undeveloped white-sand beaches for visitors and campers. Birdwatchers should not miss the nearby undeveloped barrier island of St. Vincent, just offshore from the mouth of the Apalachicola River, and the St. Vincent National Wildlife Refuge. Water shuttles are available near Port St. Joe.
5. The amazing Florida Caverns State Park in Marianna, Jackson County, is the state's only public access to underground caves. The park is a rare opportunity to tour dry caves and see dazzling formations of limestone stalactites, stalagmites, and flowstones. The park's caves have a long geological history beginning about 38 million years ago! The Chipola River and the freshwater Blue Hole Spring provide swimming, fishing, boating, and canoeing, plus the park has camping and horseback riding.

6. The Panama City area, with 27 miles of white-sand beaches and a wide variety of entertainment, continues to make Panama City a family favorite. In Panama City Beach, there's Shipwreck Island Waterpark, a 20-acre tropical landscape filled with waterslides, a lazy river, rapids, tube rides, and a wave pool. ZooWorld Zoological and Botanical Conservatory in Panama City Beach is a zoo focusing on conservation with more than 260 animals, programs, and shows in a tropical setting.



7. In Fort Walton Beach, the Gulfarium Marine Adventure Park's live exhibits and performances display a panorama of sea life, including sea lions, penguins, sharks, stingrays, and sea turtles. Open since 1955, this marine park features dolphin encounters, a snorkel swim in Stingray Bay, and shows with sharks, rays, and dolphins. At the Indian Temple Mound Museum, also in Fort Walton Beach, visitors can journey through exhibits depicting 12,000 years of Native American occupation. More than 1,000 artifacts of bone, stone, clay, and shell are exhibited from European explorers, local pirates, and early settlers. The massive Fort Walton Temple Mound, designated a National Historic Landmark in 1964, was believed to have been built in the 1500s for political, religious, and ceremonial purposes.

8. In Milton, dubbed the "Canoe Capital of Florida" thanks to the Blackwater River State Forest, visitors can canoe, kayak, and tube along the crystal-clear, spring-fed waters of the Blackwater River. It is also home to the West Florida Railroad Museum, located in the L&N Railroad Depot and open on Friday and Saturday only, devoted to preserving the railroad legacy of Northwest Florida.



9. Pensacola, at Florida's western tip, was the site of North America's first European settlement, with Spanish colonists arriving here in 1559. The place to start a family tour is Historic Pensacola Village, a complex of unique museums. Tour a portion of the Pensacola Historic District and several historic homes, including the circa 1871 Clara Barkley Dorr House, the oldest surviving example of a high house in the city, boasting beautiful grounds and spectacular views of Pensacola Bay. Visit the Discovery Gallery of the Pensacola Children's Museum and realize how five different flags have flown over the city – Spain, France, Britain, the United States, and the Confederate States of America. Geared for children aged 10 and younger, the museum allows families to meander through Creole and Victorian homes, dating from the 1780s to the 1800s, restored and converted into charming shops and restaurants.

10. For a look at Pensacola's more recent history, visitors can "take off" to explore the National Naval Aviation Museum, located at Naval Air Station Pensacola, that spans a century of military flying, from the first flight in a wood-and-fabric biplane to today's space travels with a Skylab command module. Attractions include more than 150 restored military aircraft, motion-based flight simulator rides, and an IMAX theater. Check the website for the U.S. Navy Blue Angels practice schedule.

Murals in Region 5: Much of Northwest

Florida's history can be seen in heritage sites covering hundreds of years of war, pioneer settlements, and agricultural development. The eastern Panhandle region, stretching from Pensacola to Tallahassee, known as the Capital Region, shares that history in numerous murals.

In downtown Pensacola, the Pensacola Postcard mural offers a cheerful and nostalgic welcome to visitors exploring the city's rich history and art scene. The "Wish You Were Here Pensacola" mural can be found on Palafox and Romana Streets on the side of the Zarzaur Law Firm. It is a favorite photo spot, capturing the essence of Pensacola in bold, postcard-style letters. Each letter showcases iconic imagery — from sugar-white beaches and historic architecture to the Blue Angels soaring overhead — celebrating the city's coastal charm and cultural pride.

Part of a broader public art initiative supported by Visit Pensacola and the University of West Florida Historic Trust, the mural contributes to a growing collection of outdoor artworks that tell the story of Pensacola's 450+ years of history. With nearby food trucks, easy parking, and walkable access to other murals and attractions, the postcard mural is a perfect starting point for a day of discovery. Snap a photo, grab a bite, and let Pensacola's artful spirit welcome you in.

In downtown Quincy, the restored Coca-Cola mural is more than a nostalgic nod — it's a vibrant symbol of the town's unique legacy. Located on the side of Padgett Jewelry at 21 E. Jefferson Street, the mural was unveiled in 2020 after a full restoration, celebrating over a century of partnership between Quincy and Coca-Cola. The mural honors the town's famed "Coca-Cola Millionaires," a group of locals who, guided by banker Pat Munroe in the 1920s, invested early in Coca-Cola stock and helped shape Quincy's prosperity.

With its bold colors and classic design, the mural invites visitors to step into a story where small-town vision met global success. It's a perfect stop for history buffs, art lovers, and anyone seeking a slice of Americana. Take a selfie, explore the charming downtown, and discover how a single investment turned Quincy into one of the richest small towns in America.





- 1 A local highlight is Ravine Gardens State Park in Palatka. A ravine created by water flowing thousands of years from the sandy ridges on the shore of the St. Johns River was transformed in 1933 into a dramatic garden by the Federal Works Progress Administration. Much of the original landscaping still exists as formal gardens and an extensive trail system. The peak flowering period is the azalea season, February to April. The 59-acre park is listed on the National Register of Historic Places.
- 2 In Putnam County, visitors can tour the Welaka National Fish Hatchery and Aquarium, Florida's only warm-water fish hatchery used by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service to raise fish for stocking programs throughout the southeast. Instead of driving off the birds attracted by the ponds, the hatchery constructed a viewing tower for birdwatchers, who see bald eagles, ospreys, egrets, herons, anhingas, white ibises, and wood storks.

3. Flagler County offers the Flagler Beach Fishing Pier, which overlooks smooth, sandy beaches and serves as a prime location for sunning or fishing. Known as the quiet side of Florida, the area offers spectacular natural beauty and charm, plus some of the best golf in the state. In Palm Coast, you'll find a number of golf courses with interesting layouts designed by Arnold Palmer, Gary Player, and Jack Nicklaus.

4. Visitors escape to the past in St. Augustine, the nation's oldest continuously occupied European-established settlement and port in the continental United States. Founded in 1565, 42 years before the English colonized Jamestown, St. Augustine has diligently preserved much of its rich heritage in the downtown historic district. Tour the historic area by horse-drawn carriage (something visitors have done since 1877), trolley, or on foot, armed with tour maps. Visit the 17th-century Castillo de San Marcos, the reconstructed Spanish Quarter, historic churches, and see colorful re-enactments of colonial days. St. George Street, a cobbled lane that bisects the St. Augustine historic district, offers shops, restaurants, and several historic attractions.

5. Cross Matanzas Bay by way of the fabled Bridge of Lions and you'll find yourself on Anastasia Island, home of the St. Augustine Lighthouse & Maritime Museum. Adults and children at least 44 inches tall can climb the 219 steps to reach the observation deck of the lighthouse, weather permitting. Various tours are available, including the Dark of the Moon Ghost Tour, St. Augustine's only "all ghosts, no gimmicks" paranormal tour, to explore the 1874 lighthouse tower and the keeper's house. After exploring St. Augustine, consider a drink from the Fountain of Youth, which is fortunately nearby. Commemorating Ponce de Leon's 1513 landing in the area, the legendary fountain is located on a 25-acre landscaped archaeological park overlooking the Intracoastal Waterway. Visitors can actually sip water from the famed spring of eternal youth.

6. Ponte Vedra Beach, just 20 miles southeast of Jacksonville, is home to beautiful beaches, as well as world-class tennis, shopping, and professional golf. The area's 40-foot sand dunes are among the highest in Florida. The Ponte Vedra Inn & Club is celebrating 97 years of quiet opulence, grace, stateliness, and history with its oceanfront accommodations and wide array of leisure pursuits, including miles of Atlantic beach and 36 holes of seaside golf. Golfers won't want to miss the World Golf Village, home of two championship golf courses and the World Golf Hall of Fame. The World Golf Village showcases golf's rich heritage and growing popularity in a world-class resort setting that includes upscale shopping and dining.

7. Jacksonville, "Florida's River City by the Sea," offers a festive waterfront marketplace, shopping, dining, and museums of art and history. The Cummer Museum of Art and Gardens in Jacksonville showcases 5,000 objects in its permanent collection, including art spanning from 2100 B.C. through the 21st century,

Murals in Region 6:

Northeast Florida, known as Florida's First Coast, has a distinctive southern feel, despite being the northernmost part of Florida's Atlantic Ocean coast. The region includes historic St. Augustine, metropolitan Jacksonville, rural inland towns, miles of scenic Atlantic beaches, and many beautiful murals.

In downtown Jacksonville, the Dourone mural is a mesmerizing fusion of surrealism and social commentary that invites visitors to pause and reflect. Created by Spanish artist Fabio Lopez, known as Dourone, this large-scale mural was part of the ArtRepublic initiative, which brought internationally acclaimed artists to transform Jacksonville's urban landscape. Dourone's work often explores themes of unity, diversity, and human emotion, and his Jacksonville piece is no exception — featuring bold lines, vibrant colors, and layered symbolism that speaks to the complexity of modern life.

Located on West Forsyth Street, the mural is a standout among the city's 60+ public artworks, many of which are concentrated in the downtown area. Whether you're on a self-guided mural tour or simply exploring the city, Dourone's mural offers a powerful visual experience that blends global artistry with local culture. It's a must-see for art lovers, photographers, and anyone seeking inspiration in Jacksonville.

At Jacksonville's Museum of Science and History (MOSH), a hidden gem awaits art and history lovers — the historic mural by Elmer Grey. Measuring 35 feet long, this oil-on-canvas masterpiece was originally painted in 1941 as a gift to the U.S. Navy and displayed at NAS Jacksonville for decades before being relocated to MOSH for conservation and public viewing. The mural vividly illustrates the impact of Spanish and French colonization on Northeast Florida, blending artistic beauty with historical depth.

Now housed within MOSH's "Currents of Time" exhibit, the mural complements the museum's mission to explore 12,000 years of regional history — from Indigenous cultures to modern Jacksonville. Visitors can immerse themselves in interactive exhibits, planetarium shows, and this powerful visual narrative that connects past and present. Whether you're a history buff or a curious traveler, the Elmer Grey mural offers a compelling reason to visit MOSH and experience Jacksonville's story through art.

In Palatka, the William Bartram mural offers a vivid window into the region's rich natural and cultural history. Painted by artist Dean Quigley and located on North 3rd Street, this mural commemorates Bartram's 1774 expedition up the St. Johns River, where he documented a thriving Native American village on the site of present-day Palatka. The mural is part of the Conlee-Snyder Mural Committee's efforts to preserve and celebrate local heritage through public art.

Bartram, a British botanist and explorer, was captivated by Florida's lush landscapes and diverse wildlife. His writings and illustrations introduced the world to the beauty of the region, and his visit to Palatka included encounters with cultivated orange groves and fields of corn, squash, and tobacco. Today, the mural invites visitors to step back in time and experience the wonder that inspired one of America's earliest naturalists. It's a must-see for history buffs, nature lovers, and art enthusiasts alike.



a rare porcelain collection, and 2-and-a-half acres of historic gardens. The museum was founded in 1961 after the death of Ninah Cummer, who bequeathed her gardens and personal art collection, especially strong in European and American paintings.

8. Families can explore the area's colonial past at the Fort Caroline National Memorial, the short-lived but first French colony in the present-day United States. Guided tours of the reconstructed 16th-century French fort explain the struggle between European colonial powers for control of Florida. The fort is part of the Timucuan Ecological and Historic Preserve, along with Kingsley Plantation, a state-owned historic site. Visitors here can listen to the story of Zephaniah Kingsley, a plantation owner and slave trader, as they tour the restored antebellum plantation house and tabby slave quarters. The site also showcases the lowland area's natural beauty, with spectacular views of barrier islands and savannas, and of the Theodore Roosevelt Area, 600 acres of hardwood forest, wetland, and scrub vegetation.


9. On the Atlantic coast is Amelia Island, a refreshing change of pace for RVers. On this small barrier island, visitors find blocks of old mansions, miles of beaches, and lots of seafood. The island's seaport village of Fernandina Beach showcases a collection of shops, fine restaurants, and historic homes. Tours of the historic district are conducted from the Amelia Island Museum of History, where a storytelling tradition makes it the first spoken history museum in Florida. The museum is located inside the old Nassau County jail and includes a research library and archives. It hosts a ghost tour every Friday that begins in the cemetery behind St. Peter's Episcopal Church. Beautiful natural areas can be easily found: Amelia Island State Park is located 7 miles north of Little Talbot Island State Park on State Road A1A and 8 miles south of Fernandina Beach.

10. Explore the Civil War-era Fort Clinch, one of the most well-preserved 19th-century forts in the country, at Fort Clinch State Park. In addition to the fort, the park offers great birding, fishing, shelling, swimming, picnicking, bicycling, shark-tooth hunting, and wildlife viewing. Several miles of beach with hard-packed sand can be ridden during low tide with large-tire bicycles, available for rent at the Visitor Center for a nominal fee. On the first weekend of each month, a soldier garrison fires cannons and demonstrates other battlefield skills. At sunset, watch for shrimp boats laden with the day's catch as they return to the docks.

- 1 At the southern end of Lake County, the city of Clermont used to be the “countryside” outside Orlando, but at 22 miles, that distance is easily driven today by commuters living in housing developments built on old orange groves. The Florida Citrus Tower, a 226-foot-tall structure opened in 1956, was once one of the most famous landmarks of the Orlando area, built to allow visitors to observe the miles of orange groves surrounding it. The tower’s antenna pierces the sky at 500 feet above sea level. The tower is one of the highest observation points in Florida, where visitors get a 360-degree view of eight counties from the glass-enclosed observation deck.
- 2 Lake County is named for the 1,440 lakes carved into its gently rolling landscape. It’s the ideal setting for the area’s sloping vineyards and popular Lakeridge Winery & Vineyards, a 127-acre estate in Clermont just 25 miles west of downtown Orlando. Lakeridge, a pioneer in the development of premium and sparkling wines from the native Muscadine and Vinifera grape varieties, draws thousands of visitors annually to enjoy its extensive tasting room, festivals, and gift shop. Bike riders love the challenging hills.

3 Lush parks and historic landmarks are spread throughout Mount Dora, in the eastern portion of Lake County. Specialty shops and boutiques are plentiful in the downtown area, and nearby is the famous Renninger's. This 117-acre complex includes Renninger's Vintage Antique Center and a separate Flea and Farmer's Market. Two large buildings and a number of open-air shopping areas house a wide variety of dealers from produce stands, clothing shops, and oddity vendors, to high-quality antiques and collectibles. Renninger's is also home to a large number of special events, including antique fairs and extravaganzas, car and guitar shows, swap meets, and vintage garden shows.

4 Marion County includes miles of beautiful white fences on thoroughbred horse farms, earning Ocala and Marion counties the title "Horse Capital of the World." At nearby attractions, vacationers can see antiquities at the Marion County Museum of History and Archaeology in Ocala, a research and teaching institution that covers 13,000 years of human history in the county. Marion County also boasts the vast expanse of the 378,000-acre Ocala National Forest. Hiking and biking trails offer a variety of opportunities for visitors to explore the largest sand pine forest in the world.

5 Just outside of Ocala is Silver Springs State Park, part of a natural area that has attracted visitors for well over 150 years. While Silver Springs itself is ancient, development as a tourist attraction with views of crystal-clear waters through glass-bottom boats began in the late 1870s. Tourists first arrived by stagecoach and steamboat to marvel at one of the largest artesian spring systems in the world, still one of the last uninhabited spring runs in the state. Today, Silver Springs is a 350-acre nature theme park that includes the Silver River and undeveloped Florida


wetlands teeming with native wildlife. Hiking, biking, canoeing, kayaking, glass-bottom boat rides, camping, cabins, special events, and concerts are available through a public/private partnership. The park was designated a National Natural Landmark in 1971.

6 Devil's Den Prehistoric Spring is a unique and popular natural attraction located southwest of Gainesville, in Williston, which operates as a SCUBA diving training and recreational facility. The prehistoric springs and cave are privately owned but available for exploration by snorkeling or diving. Devil's Den is a karst window that allows visitors to experience the subterranean river that winds under Florida and surfaces as springs across the state. Be sure to visit the website before planning a trip, as rainfall amounts can limit snorkeling areas. Reservations are required.

7. The city of Gainesville, home to the sprawling University of Florida campus, offers a surprising number of natural attractions along with accommodations and other amenities. The University's Florida Museum of Natural History, one of the nation's top five natural history museums, hosts permanent exhibits and frequent events.

In 2018, the museum launched the Thompson Earth Systems Institute to advance communication and public understanding of current research discoveries about Earth's natural systems – air, water, land, and life – in Florida and beyond.

8. Just south of Gainesville in Micanopy is the 21,000-acre Paynes Prairie Preserve State Park, a unique savanna designated as a National Natural Landmark. A rich array of habitats for wildlife and livestock, including alligators, bison, horses, and nearly 300 species of birds, live in numerous distinct biological communities here. This park became Florida's first state preserve in 1971 and includes a 50-foot-high observation tower for panoramic views. Noted artist and naturalist William Bartram called it the great Alachua Savannah when he wrote about his visit to the prairie in 1774. Find some great home-cooked food at the Pearl Country Store & Barbeque.

9. Cedar Key, back on the Gulf side, is a quiet island community that offers bed-and-breakfast inns, small boardwalk shops, and fresh seafood in local restaurants, making this area an enjoyable destination. Once one of Florida's most prominent ports, Cedar Key is now a quiet, rustic fishing village and artists' community. A group of fragile islands just off the coast was protected in 1929 as the Cedar Keys National Wildlife Refuge.

10. In the northern part of the region, the city of Madison, with a population of just over 3,000, was designated as one of the "Best Little Towns in Florida" by VISIT FLORIDA. Downtown Madison, and its classic 150- to nearly 200-year-old homes and buildings, is filled with quaint gift shops, antique stores, outdoor shops, and eateries. Guided walking tours of the historic downtown area are available. In the heart of downtown Madison is Four Freedoms Park, which features a memorial dedicated to World War II hero Captain Colin P. Kelly, Jr. The monument in the park is dedicated to the Four Freedoms (freedom of speech and expression, freedom of worship, freedom from want, and freedom from fear) as stated by President Franklin D. Roosevelt in his 1941 address.

Murals in Region 7: Visitors to North Central Florida, including what is called the Nature Coast, experience some of the state's most interesting historical sites. The region that stretches from Lake County around the "Big Bend" to Taylor County includes natural wonders, wide-open spaces, and historical offerings to better understand Florida's rural background, all depicted in murals.

In Jasper, the Hamilton County mural is a colorful tribute to the town's rich heritage and welcoming spirit. Located in the heart of downtown, this vibrant artwork greets visitors with imagery that reflects the area's agricultural roots, natural beauty, and historical significance. Painted by local artists and supported by community organizations, the mural is part of a broader effort to revitalize Jasper and celebrate its identity as "North Florida's Front Porch."

The mural honors figures like Revolutionary War hero Sergeant William Jasper, for whom the town is named, and evokes the region's connection to the Suwannee River and its Native American history. It's a perfect photo stop for travelers exploring Florida's quieter, scenic corners. Surrounded by historic buildings, charming shops, and the nearby Hamilton County Historical Museum, the mural invites visitors to slow down, learn, and appreciate the stories that shaped this small but proud community.

In Homosassa, the Guy Harvey and Robert Wyland mural at the Ellie Schiller Homosassa Springs Wildlife State Park is a wonderful tribute to Florida's marine life and conservation legacy. Created by two of the world's most celebrated marine artists, this mural showcases manatees in vivid detail, capturing the serene beauty of these gentle giants in their natural habitat. Wyland, known for his global "Whaling Wall" series, partnered with Harvey to leave a lasting mark in Homosassa — one that inspires awe and environmental awareness.

Located at the park's visitor center, the mural is a perfect starting point for exploring the springs, where visitors can see manatees up close, stroll through native wildlife exhibits, and enjoy scenic boardwalks. The mural's lively colors and lifelike imagery make it a favorite photo spot and a powerful reminder of Florida's commitment to protecting its natural treasures. It's a must-see for art lovers, nature enthusiasts, and anyone seeking inspiration.

FLORIDA Springs

Natural karst limestone landscapes can be seen around the world, such as the towering rock pillars in China's Shilin, formed 270 million years ago. But karst landscapes also exist underground where eroded limestone creates caves, and underground rivers often fill the landscape with water. Such is the case with Florida's freshwater springs, a karst system of underwater limestone caves flowing with water that occasionally surfaces in sinkholes. With 750 springs, Florida has the highest concentration of freshwater springs on the planet.

While Weeki Wachee and Wakulla Springs have both become world-famous, many Florida springs flow in places tucked away and far less traveled, offering a more tranquil or romantic escape into nature. For centuries, travelers have come to Florida's freshwater springs in search of their fabled ability to restore health. Though the state's springs likely won't cure what ails you, they will provide a moment of peace and profound beauty.

5. De Leon Springs State Park

6. Edward Ball Wakulla Springs State Park




Campers Inn RV was born after Arthur and Frances Hirsch had a bad experience at an RV dealership in the mid-1960s. After years of camping in a tent, they saved up some money and went to find something more comfortable. The couple brought their kids so the whole family could find the perfect RV together. However, when they arrived, the salespeople were more interested in playing cards than helping them find an RV. Art was furious. He worked as a mold maker and was wearing his work clothes that day. He felt that he had been judged on his appearance, and, by Art's standards, his money was just as green as anyone else's.

On the way home, the family had a discussion about how they were treated. That is when Art and Fran, along with their sons Robert, David and Jeffrey, decided they could do a better job running a dealership. In 1966, they invested the family's life savings, bought four folding tent trailers and began selling out of their front yard in Acton, Mass.

The whole family helped get the store going— from selling tent trailers and mounting hitches to demonstrating the unit at delivery. In the early 70s, Art decided to quit his day job and the family committed themselves to the dealership full-time. 
