FLORIDA RV TRADE ASSOCIATION-REGION 1 GENERAL SHOW RULES FOR RV DEALERS

IF THE COMMITTEE NEEDS TO MAKE A DECISION, WE ALL MUST ABIDE BY IT!

- 1) There will be no exchanging of units during show hours.
- 2) There will be no advertising or displaying in parking lot.
- 3) All vehicles and display material must stay within the dealer's paid boundary lines.
- 4) No audio or P.A. system utilization allowed.
- 5) Order of move-in determined via approved point system.
- 6) No generator operation during show hours (2-minute demo allowed with show committee approval).
- 7) All exhibits should be in good taste. Exhibitors will conduct business within their assigned space.
- 8) For the Fort Myers RV Show, ONLY NEW UNTITLED UNITS are to be displayed. New units are considered current model year and/or preceding model year only.
- 9) **LIABILITY**—Neither FRVTA-1, the show committee nor their representatives will be responsible for any injury that may arise to exhibitors or their employees or to guests or visitors while within the confines of the space or spaces contracted for by the exhibitor, or for the losses or damages to any goods from any cause whatsoever while in transit to or from the exhibition, and while in the exhibit area.
- 10) **INSURANCE AND LIABILITY**—NO EXHIBITOR CONTRACT WILL BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT PROOF OF INSURANCE. Exhibitor covenants and agrees to protect, indemnify and hold harmless FRVTA, its representatives, service contractors and the Southwest Florida and Lee County Fair Association, Inc. from any and all liability, damage or expense arising out, or connected with any injury to any person while in the Exhibitor's display area, or loss, theft, damage or injury to property resulting directly or indirectly, from any act of omission of exhibitor, or failure of exhibitor to comply with any of the terms and conditions of Region 1 of the FRVTA show rules.
- 11) **SUBLEASING**—Exhibitors may not sublease their space without the show committee's approval.
- 12) **ACTS OF GOD**—FRVTA-1 will have no liability whatsoever for any matter or thing resulting from strikes, lock-outs, fire or other acts of God; except that if exhibitor's show space has not been made available to it, FRVTA-1 will return to exhibitor payments made by exhibitor after deducting therefrom a pro-rata share of expenses incurred in connection with said show.
- 13) Minimum show purchase will be \$2500.00 unless otherwise decided by Show Committee. Any purchased space must be filled with product from said dealer's appropriate product inventory/list. Minimum two dealers inside Civic Center.
- 14) FRVTA state dues must be current and you must be a full voting member.
- 15) No cement steps in aisle displays (wood or steel OK).
- 16) Aisles must be kept open for free flow of traffic. For uniform traffic flow, doors must open to pre-designated aisle space.
- 17) All dealers MUST remove their units by noon on the Monday following the show's closing.
- 18) Each licensed dealer will draw, buy space and sell from his own inventory and NO display sharing will be allowed.
- 19) Each dealer is responsible for obtaining his own off-site sales permit and any other required permit.
- 20) NO recreation vehicle exhibit shall be removed nor any demolition be made before 5 PM Sunday of the show without written authority from the Show Committee.
- 21) Exhibitors agree to keep their exhibits open and fully staffed with proper representatives during scheduled show hours. THE BURDEN OF LIABILITY FOR THEFT OR VANDALISM OF FURNISHINGS AND ARTICLES CONTAINED THEREIN RESTS WITH EXHIBITOR.
- 22) Each Exhibitor shall be liable for the safety of its exhibits and other property against robbery, fire, accident or any other hazard whatsoever, without limitation. If insurance is desired, the Exhibitor must place it. No right or claim whatsoever shall be asserted against the Association or the owners and/or managers of the exhibit buildings and exhibit areas by any Exhibitor for the loss of or damage to any exhibits, articles of merchandise or other personal property owned, rented or leased by the Exhibitor, arising from any cause whatsoever.
- 23) No Exhibitor shall allow any article or thing to be brought into, or any act to be done on the premises, which will increase the premium on any policy or policies of insurance to be canceled.
- 24) No Exhibitor shall in any manner injure, mar or deface the said grounds or building internally or externally or permit anything to be done by its employees, agents or servants by which said premises shall in any manner be injured, marred or defaced.
- 25) **SPACE DIVIDING**—the Show Committee will govern any division of space. All space splitting must be approved by the Show Committee at the night of the draw.
- 26) The aisles and other spaces on the grounds, not leased to Exhibitors, shall be under the control of the Show Committee. All displays, interviews, conferences, distribution of literature, lectures and the transaction of business of any nature whatsoever shall be made inside the space contracted for. Standing in front of exhibit booths of other Exhibitors is prohibited.
- 27) The Show Committee shall have the power to levy charges or any labor and/or special service required as a result of an Exhibitor's failure or neglect to adhere to this contract.
- 28) By completing this contract, Exhibitor agrees to all rules listed herein.
